Canoga Park Improvement Association (CPIA) 5:00 PM, Monday January 27, 2020 Canoga Park Community Center 7248 Owensmouth Ave, Canoga Park, CA 91303

- 5:03 PM Board Meeting Commenced via John Parker
- 5:03 PM Welcome and Introductions Attendees: New property owners and prospective Board Members Nicole King and Aron Celnik were present as well as CPIA Board members John Parker, Mike Sirota, Don Rubin, Polo Gomez & Corinne Ho; CPIA Executive Director Mary Paterson; Natalie Hernandez, Bryn Lindblad from Climate Resolve; Jeff Palmer and Alexander Caiozzo from StreetsLA (Public Works); Marc Caswell, Alta Planning & Design; from CPIA marketing team, Dree Paterson; from LAPD SLO Duke Dao; from Supervisor Sheila Kuehl's office, Blake Clayton; from Assemblymember Jesse Gabriel's office, Mayra Valadez; and from Councilmember Bob Blumenfield's office, Tricia Robbins Kasson.
- 5:06 PM **Climate Resolve Presentation** was given by Marc Caswell from Alta Planning & Design with additional points and assistance given by Jeff and Alex from Street Services and Natalie and Bryn from Climate Resolve. (*Key Points*)
 - This program is needed to combat rising temperatures that will result in extreme heat for Canoga Park.
 - Canoga Park is the prospective model for future likened implementations.
 - Three areas of Canoga Park will be used for the said model.
 - Multiple community outreach efforts have been done (presentations, community survey, targeted online advertising, door to door and workshops)
 - 3 areas of potential major funding have been identified.
 - One interesting design proposal was to permanently close Owensmouth from the alley north of Sherman Way to Wyandotte St.

 - Trees were an important presented feature. Polo Gomez cautioned that planting trees without a sufficient city maintenance plan can be problematic. Presenters assured that tree maintenance plan will be included, to help all future structures from buildings to trees to trash cans stay well-kept.
- 5:55 PM LAPD / Security Report via Duke Dao
 - Captain Mendoza is leaving and in his place will be Captain Tom Hankle
 - Crime is overall down but cars are still getting broken into.
 - Illegal weed shops are being shut down all the time and the only Legal shop currently in our district is Coast to Coast on Canoga, South of Sherman Way. Reminder: If you see something, say something. They need a description of the suspect and time & date to best help stop illegal activity. Executive Director

reminder officer Dao about our concerns that the illegal pot shop formerly known as Mary Jane Cafe located at 21608 Sherman Way may be open again for the same use and to let us know what they find. This location was last raided and closed down On November 4.

- 6:00 PM Brief reports by Elected Officials Reps
 - Blake Clayton, Supervisor Sheila Kuehl: homeless clean-up LA River
 - Mayra Valadez, Assemblymember Jesse Gabriel: Housing /Homeless a priority, also Higher education access and affordability and access to legal aid; recognition given to CPIA Executive Director Mary Paterson
 - Trisha Robbins, Councilmember Bob Blumenfield: chimed in on discussion of homelessness and Bride Housing; invited people to reach out to their office as they consider themselves to be a conduit to the city; and mentioned that sober living homes are all over the valley and are difficult to regulate.
 - Corinne Ho reported that for the recent homeless count there were approximately 34 people in Canoga Park which is a decrease from previous years at over 200. Also that according to the LAHSA, it takes 37 visits for a person facing homelessness to accept services or assistance.
